Covenant House Academy COVID-19 Vaccinations

Dear Covenant House Academy Students and Families, When the Titanic sank in the North Atlantic in 1912, nearly 1,500 people died. While some perished immediately or were trapped below, most people had enough time to get into a lifeboat. Strangely enough, though, many of the lifeboats had empty seats. It was one of the most vivid recollections of many survivors. Those empty seats were lives that could have been saved. We are facing a disaster in this country that has already claimed as many lives as 378 Titanic disasters, 12 in Michigan alone. The COVID disaster is not over. In our state, the rates of new cases, hospitalizations and fatalities are all rising rapidly. This is even true for younger, healthy adults. But there are seats in the lifeboat. Michigan will now vaccinate any individual 16 years old or above. These vaccines will make you 20 times less likely to catch COVID. With more than 65 million vaccine shots administered in the United States so far, there have been no known fatalities due to the vaccine. In extremely rare cases (less than 1 in a million), there have been serious side effects. Many people experience aches and mild fever for 24-36 hours, much like a flu.

This is the bottom line: we are far more likely to become ill (or worse) from COVID than from the vaccine. We understand that some of you are reluctant to receive the vaccine. Some of us waited until very recently to get it, but nearly 80% of our staff is now fully vaccinated. While we still wear masks and follow safety protocols, it makes us feel safer and enables us to see our loved ones. We are not requiring CHA students to be vaccinated against COVID-19 to attend school and have no immediate plans to do so. But we strongly encourage every CHA student, parent and family member 16 or older to get vaccinated unless a doctor advises against it. Please call your local health department to make an appointment if you are not already vaccinated. If you do not know who to call, call us and we will help you. Let's make sure that we fill every seat in the lifeboat -- and save every life possible.
