Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2017-18 educational progress for the Covenant House Academy Detroit, Central. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2017-18 school year, schools were identified using definitions and labels as required in Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has three or more underperforming student subgroups. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or has a graduation rate at or below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. Covenant House Academy Detroit, Central has not been given any of these distinctions.

Key Challenges and Initiatives Employed to Close Achievement Gaps

Covenant House Academy Detroit Central is an alternative high school that is designed for overage and under-credited youth. Many of our students are homeless and have disengaged from the educational process. As a result, the students have experienced many challenges with navigating the various pathways to earn a high school diploma. These challenges include, poverty, hopelessness, and severe academic deficiencies. Considering these findings, our school will continue to implement the following steps to improve our school accountability status:

- 1. Incorporate 21st century after-school enrichment activities into our program for the purposes of developing the students' artistic abilities, and career readiness skills.
- 2. Implementing more targeted small group instruction using Common Core Standards and Marzano's instructional and vocabulary strategies.

- 3. Developing gender-specific mentoring programs to address attendance, behavior, and social issues.
- 4. Continued implementation and monitoring of our Section 23a program for the purposes of assisting our most-challenged students to obtain a high school diploma.

State law requires that we also report additional information.

Process for Assigning Pupils to the School

Covenant House Academy Detroit, Central is a Public-School Academy, authorized by Grand Valley State University and follows the Open Enrollment policies for the state of Michigan. Students who want to enroll in our school may do so throughout the school year. We have a rolling enrollment process that is open until the school reaches capacity. When the maximum enrollment has been reached, applications shall be placed on a waiting list and admitted based on lottery system. Covenant House Academy Detroit, Central did not need to hold a lottery for the following school years: 2016-2017, and 2017-2018. The enrollment process involves completing the required application packet and conducting an orientation with the prospective student with the parent as well as the guardian. During this process, future enrollees learn about the policies and procedures of the school; ensure all the paperwork is complete; and participate in an introductory course in our online courseware.

The Status of the 3-5 Year School Improvement Plan

Covenant House Academy Detroit, Central is in the fifth year of continuous improvement efforts with our School Improvement Plan. The 2016-2017 school year represented our fourth year in updating the assessment data, and our funding sources to support our goal and activities in our School Improvement Plan. We will continue to modify our School Improvement Plan for the upcoming year.

A Brief Description of Each Specialized School

Covenant House Academy Detroit, Central provides at-risk youth and high school dropouts the opportunity to earn a high school diploma, improve their life skills, and continue to higher education or post-secondary employment training. The educational design of our program serves students ages 16 to 22. Our mission-focused staff works toward preventing poverty, underachievement, and homelessness for our students; while offering them hope, encouragement, and a better chance for future success. We offer small class sizes, and an abbreviated year-round educational program that allows students to maintain employment, or care for children, and continue their high school education. In addition, we offer multiple pathways for our students to earn a high school diploma. These pathways include blended learning, dropout recovery, and credit recovery.

Core Curriculum and Implementation

Covenant House Academy Detroit, Central has partnered with Kickstand to enhance our computer-based curriculum. The courses are aligned with the Michigan Merit Curriculum which specifies the standards, benchmarks and content expectations at each grade level and content area K-12. The state of Michigan has adopted the Common Core State Standards (CCSS) as our curricular standards and benchmarks. During the 2016-2017 school year we modified the Edify courses and the assessments to increase rigor and improve student engagement. In the 2017-2018 school year, the efforts to continue to improve the rigor, relevance, and the engagement of the content were met with minimal satisfaction. Aggregate Student Achievement

The alternative assessment for Covenant House Academy Detroit, Central is the ACT WorkKeys. Our authorizer, Grand Valley State University, has approved WorkKeys as the internal metric for educational performance at Covenant House Academy Detroit, Central. As a result, this internal metric cannot be compared to the state average or other local school districts. All students are tested in the fall and in the spring for the purposes of measuring growth. Student growth is measure by a formula of time as measured by 180 days of enrollment in the school as opposed to growth as measured by student achievement. A National Career Readiness Certificate is earned by achieving a Level Score of 3 or better on all three WorkKeys assessments. The three assessed areas are Applied Math, Graphic Literacy, and Workplace Documents. The ranking of the certificate levels from lowest to highest are: Bronze, Silver, Gold, and Platinum. Our school performance goal is a level three (3) score which is the Bronze Certificate. The test results are as follows: There were 70 students who completed all three tests between the Spring of 2017 and January of 2018. Twenty-one (21) students were awarded the Bronze Certificate; and four (4) students were awarded the Silver Certificate. There were 66 students who completed all three tests for the Spring of 2018 test administration. Sixteen (16) students were awarded the Bronze Certificate; and three (3) students were awarded the Silver Certificate. The test data for the 2016-2017 school year, was inconclusive due to the testing change from a previous assessment.

Parent Teacher Conferences

We strongly encourage parental involvement in our school. The percentage of parents represented at Parent Teacher Conferences for the 2017-2018 School Year was 30%. This is a five percent improvement from last year's participation rate of 25%. At the beginning of each

year, we hold our Open House Meeting in which we invite all parents and guardians to visit and tour our school to experience "a day in the life" of a student at Covenant House Academy Detroit, Central. We also conduct periodic parent meetings through out the year. Parent Teacher Conferences are held three times per year. In addition, parents can schedule meetings with the teachers at any time. Last year, we held our Annual Title I Right to Know meeting on September 21, 2018. We are continuing to inform parents of meetings via phone calls, letters, and web site postings. Our goal is to strive to increase parent participation each year.

Dual Enrollment/College Credits

Covenant House Academy Detroit, Central did not have any of the following list below for the 2016-2017 school year or the 2017-2018 school year:

- a. We had no students who were dual enrolled.
- b. We do not offer college equivalent courses.
- c. No students were enrolled in college equivalent courses.
- d. None of our students received scores toward college credits.

We take great pride in our students' determination to overcome the obstacles that stand between them and success in completing their high school education. The staff at Covenant House Academy Detroit, Central are committed to helping their dreams of earning a high school diploma a reality. We appreciate the continuing support of parents and staff and our community in this effort. Our team is looking forward to a productive year of providing quality programming that will prepare our students for life after high school.
