GVSU OFFERS TUITION-FREE PROGRAM FOR QUALIFIED STUDENTS FROM SIX MICHIGAN COUNTIES

Leaders at Grand Valley State University are committed to opening access to higher education and have announced a tuition-free program for students from low-income backgrounds who live in six Michigan counties.

The Grand Valley Pledge awards full undergraduate tuition (renewable for four years) to qualified students from counties where the university has a physical presence: Kent, Ottawa, Muskegon, Grand Traverse, Calhoun and Wayne.

Students must be admitted to Grand Valley, beginning in the fall 2021 semester, and have a family income of less than \$50,000 (GVSU, 2021).

Apply today for Michigan Reconnect Get your degree, tuition free!

Gov. Gretchen Whitmer joined Republican and Democratic legislators to announce the launch of the \$30 million Michigan Reconnect program, the largest effort in state history to ensure that more than 4.1 million Michiganders who are 25 or older and don't have a college degree will have an opportunity to earn a tuition-free associate degree or skills certificate. Michigan Reconnect will help pay the costs of tuition or training for eligible adults who want to pursue an associate degree or skills certificate at their in-district community college. The program also offers skills scholarships to help cover the cost of tuition through more than 70 private training schools with 217 programs which offer certificates in high-demand careers in industries such as manufacturing, construction, information technology, healthcare or business management.

Grand Rapids Community College is now tuition-free for eligible Kent Intermediate School District residents 25 years and older through Michigan Reconnect. GRCC M-TEC Champions Program

The Grand Rapids Community College M-TEC Champions program will empower you with the resources to start a career that is secure and pays well. You will work closely with a Career Coach who will support you throughout this program. If you qualify, you will attend a six-week personal training program that will prepare you for five possible technical career tracks. Once you successfully complete Readiness Bootcamp, you will choose and receive training in a technical career track. Each technical training program focuses on building skills and credentials to qualify you for an entry-level position in that field! Your training schedule will depend on which career track you choose.

Bootcamp meets weekly Feb. 8 – March 18, 2021, Monday through Thursday, from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. Lunch will be included each day.
